The Community War Memorials Fund was established in 2007 by the New South Wales State Government to help protect and conserve war memorials across NSW.

Grants are offered twice a year and close on Anzac Day and on Remembrance Day. All submissions are assessed by the State War Memorials Committee.

Applications are invited from local councils, community organisations and veterans groups across NSW.
