

NSW VETERANS EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

What is the Veterans' Employment Program (VEP)?

The VEP facilitates merit-based employment for former ADF personnel looking to move into a career in the NSW public sector.

Who is it for?

The employment program is intended to encourage former military people into government roles for the benefit of both the individual and the people of NSW.

Who is eligible to apply under the VEP?

All current and former members of the military who are interested in commencing a new career within the NSW public sector are encouraged to apply for roles.

What sort of assistance will be provided to veterans?

At the heart of the program is an education campaign to help NSW Government employers better understand the unique skills and training that former ADF personnel can offer to their organisation. A web portal at vep.veterans.nsw.gov.au will also assist former military people to identify the roles and positions that may be best suited to their military skills, attributes and level of seniority and link them to these roles through the [I Work for NSW](http://www.workfor.nsw.gov.au) website.

Will there be further assistance available once veterans are employed?

Within the NSW public sector, all employees are encouraged to undertake training where appropriate for their role. This will apply to those applying under the VEP.

Which NSW Government departments or agencies will participate in the VEP?

All NSW public sector departments support the program. Department and agency heads and senior HR personnel will now be able to consider how veterans' experience and skills complement the NSW Public Sector Capability Framework.

Where will jobs be located?

This program encompasses all NSW Government jobs across the state as advertised on the I Work for NSW website.
