# Start Point for the March i.e. not your form up position

As per the map participants are to be made aware your contingent form up position is not where you will be stepping off from for the March. As the March commences the contingents will move around to the start line of the March which is at Martin Place and Elizabeth Street. If any veteran needs assistance to get to the starting point there will be marshals transporting veterans in golf carts. Once participants step off they will proceed to march south down Elizabeth Street.

### Leave the insertion of bands to the Chief Band Marshal via the Band Chute

The marshals request that you leave the bands who are marching in front of the contingents to the Chief Band Marshal to insert where required via the Band Chute. The Chief Band Marshal has a list of all the bands participating, who they march ahead of and how many times they wish to go around the circuit.

Contingents inserting bands into the March without the Chief Band Marshal knowing causes confusion and the script for the ABC telecast to be incorrect.

#### **Taxis to replace Land Rovers**

2016 was the last year Land Rovers will be used in the march as they will be decommissioned and the new ones brought in will not be adequate for senior veterans

The NSW Taxi Council will make a number of maxi taxis available for senior veterans to replace Land Rovers.

There will be 3 pick-up points to be advised in future updates. Please check back for future updates regarding this point or this information will be passed onto participants at Participants Meetings.

### Pedestrian crossing and under pass at Park Street

For spectators or people wishing to cross over the street to the Hyde Park to attend the ANZAC Commemoration Service from 1230 they will be able to so via a pedestrian crossing at Park Street and an under pass at Bathurst Street. Please look out for the Police or Traffic Management Company staff that will assist veterans and their families with crowd control.

### Follow direction of Marshals in the Dispersal Point

To avoid a choke point at the end of the march we ask all participants to follow the direction of the Marshals in the Dispersal Point. This includes turning left up Liverpool Street or continuing down Elizabeth Street at the discretion of the marshals.

Bands wheel right into Liverpool St and use Castlereagh St to return to the start line if bands wish to complete another circuit.

# **Enhanced Act of Remembrance**

There will be larger bunting and/or a banner on the side of the road to notify contingents when to give their eyes left and bands to commence a drum tap.
