**KOREA 2016 COMMEMORATIVE MISSION**

Proposed Australian Government commemorative mission to the Republic of Korea in October 2016.

The purpose of the Mission is to conduct activities to commemorate the 65<sup>th</sup> anniversaries of the Battles of Kapyong and Maryang San and the service and sacrifices of Australians in the Korean War. The mission is timed to occur around United Nations Day on 24 October 2016.

The Minister for Veterans' Services would like to invite nominations from Australian veterans who served in the Korean War, 1950-53 (including nurses who served with the Royal Australian Army Nursing Corps and the Royal Australian Air Force Nursing Service).

Veterans may self-nominate if they wish. Nomination forms are also available on the Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) website ([www.dva.gov.au](http://www.dva.gov.au)) under "Commemorative Missions" accessible via the "Commemorative and War Graves" Quick Link from the DVA website homepage.

In view of the logistical requirements in arranging the visit, it will be necessary to receive all nominations by no later than **1700 hrs AEST Friday, 13 May 2016**.
