<p><u>Monument Hill – Albury Wodonga</u></p> <p>Memorial Drive Albury NSW 2640</p>	<p>Excellent views of Albury-Wodonga can be seen from the hill where the War Memorial is located.</p> <p>The monument was designed by architect Louis Harrison in 1923 and erected in 1924 at a cost of 3,000 pounds.
