

Checklist for services held at the Cenotaph

□ Applied for permission from the Custodian of the Cenotaph
□ Applied for permission from the City of Sydney
□ Advised NSW Police Events Planning Unit of your service
□ Sent in your ADF Ceremonial Support Request
□ Booked AV – please note no speakers or equipment is to be set up within the chained off area
□ Booked infrastructure – chairs, marquees etc
\Box Advised suppliers that vehicle access to Martin Place must be approved by the City of Sydney – collection of bollard key may be required
□ Booked first aid
□ Confirmed access to power onsite through the City of Sydney – security key/tool may be required
□ Carried out a risk assessment for your service
□ Have an adverse weather plan in place
□ Advised RSL NSW of any ADF rehearsal times
Please refer to the RSL NSW Commemoration Ceremony Standard Procedures to ensure your service follows a traditional Order of Service. A copy can be found on rslnsw.org.au
COVID-19
□ Check the <u>nsw.gov.au</u> website for the most up to date information on what you can and can't do
□ Register as COVIDSafe to receive your QR check in code (if applicable)
□ Develop and comply with a COVID Safety Plan (if applicable)
